NOTE: The accessories described in this instruction manual are intended for use with Marley Engineered Products convectors series DBA, ASL3, SHA and ASL5.




- Be sure electric power is disconnected at main fuse or circuit breaker distribution panel before installation or servicing.
- 2. The installation must comply with all Local and National Electrical Codes and utility requirements.
- Refer to installation instructions provided with the heater when installing this accessory.

SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS

INSTALLATION

- Refer to heater Installation Instructions to determine mounting height limitations.
- Determine mounting location and desired mounting height.
 Draw a horizontal pencil line at location of bottom of heater.
 The line should be level or parallel with the window sill if mounting under a window.
- Remove the heater cover as described in heater Installation Instructions, to provide access to the interior of the heater.





- Position the Stand-off Bracket on the wall just above the line drawn in Step 2. (See Figure 2.)
- Securely mount the Stand-off Bracket on the wall using four (4) screws (not provided). Four (4) predrilled holes in the bracket flanges are provided for these screws.
- Repeat Steps 4 and 5 for the bracket on the opposite end of the heater.
- Refer to Table 1 to determine if additional brackets are required. If they are, position the heater onto the two brackets installed in Steps 4, 5 and 6. Position additional brackets (equally spaced, if possible) and mark desired mounting location on the wall.
- 8. Mount the additional brackets in the same manner as before, using four (4) screws through the four (4) pre-drilled holes in the flanges.



TO AVOID POSSIBLE DAMAGE TO THE HEATER, USE CARE WHEN DRILLING HOLES TO AVOID TOUCHING ANY INTERNAL HEATER COMPONENTS.

 Position the heater onto the stand-off brackets. Drill a hole through the back housing of the heater into each bracket. (See Figure 3.).

Note: Drill size should be appropriate for the size sheet metal screw to be used.



 Mount the heater to the Stand-off Brackets using sheet metal screws (one per bracket).

Note: No. 10 x 1/2-inch (M10 x 1,25 x 12,7 mm) or larger screws should be used.

INSTALLATION OF MULTIPLE HEATERS (End-to-End)

Note: Heaters may butt against each other, thus eliminating the filler piece, if so desired.

For installation of heaters end-to-end, the alignment tab, provided with each heater, should be used to maintain alignment of the heaters. See heater instructions for procedure to install alignment tabs.
