




Wiring Diagram for "QR" Relay Accessory

CAUTION A

TO AVOID POSSIBLE ELECTRICAL SHOCK, MAKE SURE ALL POWER IS DISCONNECTED AT SUPPLY BEFORE INSTALLING OR WIRING. ALL WIRING MUST BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE REQUIREMENTS. ALL CONTROL WIRING MUST BE NEC CLASS 1 RATED 90°MIN.

INSTALLATION OF POWER RELAY

- Install the power relay as shown in Figure 1, using the two screws provided for attachment.
- 2. To wire the power relay, refer to the wiring diagram, Figure 2 and proceed as follows.
 - Disconnect the two blue wires from the terminal board contacts L2E/A and L2E/B.
 - b.) Connect the two blue wires from the terminal board to the red leads from the relay using wire nuts provided.
 - c.) Connect the two blue wires from the relay to the terminal board contacts marked L2E/A and L2E/B.
 - d.) Connect control voltage cable (from others) to the two black leads from relay (QR 24) or black and white leads(QR 120). All control wiring must be NEC Class I.
- 3. A snap bushing is provided to be used in the knockout hole for control wiring.



LIMITED WARRANTY
